Clay:

Tools:

HOME
Dedicated space to work. With a generous water bucket at hand. A kitchen table, or other sturdy table will work fine.
Rolling Pin, or other cylinder shapes object.
Pottery Knife, or any other blunt end knife.
Items to create texture in the clay. Use your imagination! Anything you may have at home with texture will work. For example, lace or interesting kitchen utensils.
A plastic or metal bowl to shape your clay. Or, any round object will work.
A cordless drill or any other sharpe object to make holes in your clay. For example; A wide nail would work.
Keep your area clean by placing plastic or paper down to cover the floor area you will be working on.

Glaze Firing:

Bisque Firing	\$5.00
The name Biscuit firing or Bisque firing as it's sometimes known is given to the very first firing of pottery before it is glazed.	
Glaze Firing	\$10.00
Ceramic glaze is an impervious layer or coating applied to bisqueware to color, decorate, or waterproof an item.
